#### **1 Update on Caledonia Protest**

Staff Sergeant Rose provided an update on the Caledonia Protest, noting the timeline and summary of demonstration events at the McKenzie Meadows site in Caledonia. It was emphasized that public and officer safety was the O.P.P.'s first priority. Discussion ensued regarding the injunction process, rule of law and police framework. The Board expressed their dissatisfaction with the way the situation was handled. The Board and County staff recognize that the decisions made were not from the local detachment. It was noted that the blocking of roads is not a unique situation in our community and this issue appeared to exacerbate the frustration amongst residents and visitors. The Board further expressed their

displeasure with the occupation/protest event stating that they do not believe the community is being provided adequate and effective policing.
