By-law Number /18

Being a by-law to authorize the Mayor and Clerk to execute an Agreement with the Selkirk Baptist Church and the Selkirk Chamber of Commerce

WHEREAS Sections 8 and 9 (1) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, C.25, as amended, provide that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising authority to govern affairs as considered appropriate and to enhance the ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of Haldimand County deems it expedient to enter into a Shared Driveway Agreement and Use Agreement with the Selkirk Baptist Church and the Selkirk Chamber of Commerce for ongoing access to Selkirk Park and for a project to rehabilitate Memorial Gates at the entrance,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and instructed to execute a Shared Driveway Agreement and Use Agreement with the Selkirk Baptist Church and the Selkirk Chamber of Commerce for use of a portion of certain lands located on Regional Road #3 (17 Kent Street North), Selkirk, ON, NOA 1GO, legally described as PIN #38204-0308(LT) Lot 10, N/S Kent Street, 11 N/S Kent Street, 11 S/S Main Street, Plan 357 except Part 5 on 18R-1593, Haldimand County, effective from June 26, 2018 until June 25, 2028 at a cost of \$1.00 (One Dollar) per annum.
- 2. **THAT** the Mayor and Clerk of Haldimand County are hereby authorized and instructed to execute any other documents required to give effect to the intention of this by-law, and the Clerk of Haldimand County is hereby authorized to affix the Corporate Seal of the Municipality to this by-law and to all other documents as may be required herein.
- 3. **AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take full effect from the date of passage thereof.

READ a first and second time this 25th day of June, 2018.

READ a third time and finally passed this 25^{th} day of June, 2018.
