

THE CORPORATION OF HALDIMAND COUNTY

By-law Number /18

Being a by-law to amend By-law 307/02 to regulate parking in Haldimand County – Lock Street, Dunnville

WHEREAS Section 10 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 S. O. 2001 c. 25, as amended, (“the Act”) provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting any service or things that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

WHEREAS in accordance with the Act, the Council of the Corporation of Haldimand County enacted the By-law 307/02 to regulate and govern traffic and the parking of vehicles on private or municipal property in Haldimand County;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of Haldimand County now deems it expedient to amend By-law 307/02 with respect to parking regulations on Lock Street East in Dunnville,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** Schedule “C” No Parking – Dunnville of By-law 307/02 be amended to repeal the section as follows:

STREET	SIDE	FROM	TO	PERIOD
Lock Street East	North	Cedar Street	34 metres easterly	Anytime
Lock Street East	South	Cedar Street	22 metres easterly	Anytime

2. **THAT** Schedule “C” No Parking – Dunnville of By-law 307/02 be amended to add the section as follows:

STREET	SIDE	FROM	TO	PERIOD
Lock Street East	North	Cedar Street	20 metres easterly	Anytime
Lock Street East	South	Cedar Street	15 metres easterly	Anytime

3. **THAT** this by-law shall take precedence over any other by-law with which is inconsistent.
4. **AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect when signage applicable to this provision has been installed and is on display.

READ a first and second time this 25th day of June, 2018.

READ a third time and finally passed this 25th day of June, 2018.
