Executive Summary

The locations recommended for the deployment of the mounted speed signs were removed as well as locations that did not meet the deployment requirements of the trailer.




Recommendations

The Mobile Speed Trailer requires ample road shoulder space to be deployed which makes efficient urban deployment difficult. Deployment locations have been modified to take the deployment requirements into account. It is recommended that the additional EZ Stat Data logger be purchased for the trailer in order to log speed data which will assist with enforcement recommendations. The maps provided below will be the most efficient for the initial sign placement.


See the maps below for initial placement locations.
