

THE CORPORATION OF HALDIMAND COUNTY

By-law Number /18

Being a by-law to further amend By-law 1064/10, as amended, being a by-law to regulate or prohibit signs and other advertising devices

WHEREAS Section 10(2) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, C.25, as amended, provides that single-tier municipalities may pass by-laws respecting structure, including signs;

WHEREAS By-law 1064/10, the Haldimand County Sign By-law, was enacted and further amended to regulate or prohibit signs and other advertising devices in Haldimand county;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to amend the Haldimand County Sign By-law to include a definition for “registered third party advertisers” as referenced in the *Municipal Election Act, 1996*,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the definition for “SIGN, ELECTION” in By-law 1064/10 be amended with the addition of the following between the words “candidate” and “participating”:

“or registered third party advertiser, as defined under provincial or federal legislation”.

2. **AND THAT** this by-law come into effect on the date of passing.

READ a first and second time this 11th day of June, 2018.

READ a third time and finally passed this 11th day of June, 2018.
