## **Trail Matrix Scoring Process**

The evaluation scoring of each proposed name was based upon 3 categories:

1. The criteria outlined within the naming policy;

2. Additional documentation associated with the name that was provided in support of the nomination; and

3. Additional relevant background and research which was added to the discussion by the Advisory Committee.

In terms of implementing the policy, the practice for all corporate naming since it was put in place has been that each category has been assigned a weight to determine a final score.

1. Criteria 50%;

- 2. Additional documentation 30%; and
- 3. Additional relevant background 20%.

The Advisory committee reviewed each name with each specific criteria set out in the policy and through discussion came to a consensus as to the eligibility. If eligible, each name was awarded one point per criteria if it met it and no points if not. Similarly, discussion and consensus amongst the committee resulted in the scoring of the background information submitted and any additional information provided by members.

Prior to the preparation of the staff report the additional relevant background that was provided either by the applicant or through the advisory committee knowledge was verified through research and additional research by staff.
