#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The completion of the recent road work in Hagersville has resulted in changes that require amendments to the existing Haldimand County Parking By-law and Winter Control By-law.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

As a result of the recent road work in Hagersville amendments are required to the existing Haldimand County Parking By-law and Winter Control By-laws to reflect the new street parking configuration.

A summary of the changes to the parking regulations proposed in this report are as follows:

- Amendments to the Winter Control By-law to extend the snow route limits on Main Street North to the limit of the connecting link for ease of plowing during winter events.
- Amendments to the No Stopping limits on Main Street South and King Street East to create buffer zones at the marked school crossings.
- The addition of a No Parking zone in front of the Canada Post box on MacNeil Court.
- Amendments to the 2 Hour Parking (Restricted Parking) zones along Main Street North to reflect the painted parking stalls.
- Amendments to the Accessible Parking By-law to add an accessible parking spot near the CIBC bank on King Street West and two accessible spots at Grant Kett Park (one spot is currently signed but is not by-lawed).
- Minor by-law housekeeping issues noted during the review of the existing by-laws and signage.

In order to create the new parking regulations, the following changes are required to Haldimand County Winter Control Parking By-law 302/02 and Parking Control By-law 307/02:
