Speed Spy Study

A speed spy study was conducted between 12 April 2019 and 15 April 2019 as a result of a speeding complaint along Kohler Rd in Cayuga Rural. This is an 80 km/hr zone consisting of a straight flat roadway with one Northbound and one Southbound lane. Only Southbound traffic was measured in this study.

The results are as follows:

S/B Traffic

Average Speed (km/h):	54 km/h
Highest Speed (km/h):	147 km/h
50th Percentile:	67 km/h
85th Percentile:	86 km/h
Number Above Speed Limit:	2104
Number Above Speed Limit (+20 km/hr):	329
Percentage above Speed limit (+20 km/hr)	3.92%
Total Number of Vehicles:	8389

In reviewing the data for southbound traffic, 8389 vehicles were recorded with the average speed at 54 km/h. The 85th percentile was travelling at 86 km/h. The highest speed recorded was 147 km/h. The data also indicated that of the 8389 vehicles recorded, 329 of them were travelling at least 20 km/hr over the speed limit representing 3.92% of the vehicles recorded.


