

THE CORPORATION OF HALDIMAND COUNTY

By-law Number 2037/19

Being a by-law to restrict heavy vehicle traffic turning at specific intersections in Haldimand County

WHEREAS Section 27 (1) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, c. 25., as amended, authorizes municipalities to pass by-laws in respect of a highway under its jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County deems it expedient to regulate and prohibit heavy vehicle turning in Haldimand County,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:

1. In this by-law,

“Heavy Vehicle” shall include any vehicle or combination of vehicle which exceeds 14.0 metres in length.
2. **THAT** no person shall cause a heavy vehicle which is travelling northbound on Main Street to make a left turn onto King Street in Hagersville in Haldimand County.
3. **THAT** no person shall cause a heavy vehicle which is travelling northbound on Main Street to make a right turn onto King Street in Hagersville in Haldimand County.
4. **THAT** no person shall cause a heavy vehicle which is travelling Southbound on Main Street to make a left turn onto King Street in Hagersville in Haldimand County.
5. **THAT** no person shall cause a heavy vehicle which is travelling Southbound on Main Street to make a right turn onto King Street in Hagersville in Haldimand County.
6. **THAT** no person shall cause a heavy vehicle which is travelling Eastbound on King Street to make a left turn onto Main Street in Hagersville in Haldimand County.
7. **THAT** no person shall cause a heavy vehicle which is travelling Eastbound on King Street to make a right turn onto Main Street in Hagersville in Haldimand County.
8. **THAT** no person shall cause a heavy vehicle which is travelling Westbound on King Street to make a left turn onto Main Street in Hagersville in Haldimand County.

9. **THAT** no person shall cause a heavy vehicle which is travelling Eastbound on King Street to make a right turn onto Main Street in Hagersville in Haldimand County.
10. **THAT** every person contravening any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is subject to a fine recoverable under the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.33, as amended.
11. **THAT** this by-law shall take precedence over any other by-law with which it is inconsistent.
12. **THAT** By-law 95/01, be hereby repealed.
13. **AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect when signage applicable to this provision has been installed and is on display.
