

## THE CORPORATION OF HALDIMAND COUNTY

By-law Number /19

### Being a by-law to restrict heavy vehicle traffic turning at specific intersections in Haldimand County and to repeal By-law 2037/19

**WHEREAS** Section 27 (1) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, c. 25., as amended, authorizes municipalities to pass by-laws in respect of a highway under its jurisdiction;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County deems it expedient to regulate and prohibit heavy vehicle turning in Haldimand County,

**NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:**

1. In this by-law,  
  
“Heavy Vehicle” shall include any vehicle or combination of vehicle which exceeds 14.0 metres in length.
2. **THAT** no person shall, while driving a Heavy Vehicle along Main Street North/South or King Street East/West, make a left or right turn at the intersection of Main Street and King Street in Hagersville where a sign prohibiting the turn is posted.
3. **THAT** every person contravening any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is subject to a fine recoverable under the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.33, as amended.
4. **THAT** this by-law shall take precedence over any other by-law with which it is inconsistent.
5. **THAT** By-law 2037/19, be hereby repealed.
6. **AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect when signage applicable to this provision has been installed and is on display.

READ a first and second time this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 2019.

READ a third time and finally passed this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 2019.
