

Regarding the church going up

I wouldn't of been there if it wasn't for someone <sup>ANTA</sup> knocking on my door at 6:30 PM that night, as she got her notice that day.

I don't know how many were mailed out but it seemed they wanted as few people there as possible. I showed 3 people there where the property line was. Richard Schilstra told me that they are dreaming if they think they are going to fill the parking lot. I asked him about a gate and he told me "that not going to happen." all this I found very insulting. I asked if I could buy some of the land and he said "why would you want to to that." I did before all this told BEN who was interested in buying some or all the land behind me, before the church wanted it. ~~He~~ RICHARD was going to talk to the ENGINEERS

and get back to us. I was pointing out that the parking lot was not laid out efficiently and they could put more spots at the back about 18. I wanted the ~~lots~~ spots close to us removed to give us more space. Truth is I don't want it behind us at all and I told RICHARD that too. He said he would get back to us <sup>MAY 24</sup> (still waiting). The only way we could remotely go along with this is if we could add 60' by width to the back of our property which would put us 18' into the established tree line and we can start planting more trees.
