





So many volunteers, one uniting goal.

CAA

- Provides all program materials (training resources, handbooks and safety vests)
- Organizes regional and province-wide reward/recognition incentives for Patrollers
- Monitors the School Safety Patrol program to ensure adherence to program standards
- Liaises with program partners on a regular basis

School Boards/Schools/Teachers

- Grant permission for their schools to participate
- Appoint Patrol Supervisor to lead School Safety Patrol program
- Patrol Supervisor recruits/selects students, obtains parental consent, schedules shifts and meetings, supervises and recognizes patrol team

Program Partners (i.e. Police Services/Busing Consortia)

- Train students
- Liaise with CAA on a regular basis
- Assist in local Patroller incentives

Parents/Guardians

- Give permission for students to participate in program

Student Patrollers (11-14 years of age)

- Foot Patrollers help students cross roads safely
- Bus Patrollers help the bus driver transport students safely

Perks and recognition for Patrollers:

- Awards given annually to top Patrollers, Patrol Supervisors and outstanding program partners
- Recognition is given at special events, on social media, through pictures and videos
- CAA works with partners to provide incentives for Patrollers in their local communities
