HALDIMAND COUNTY

Report ENG-02-2020 Avalon Phase 1, 2, 3A1 and 3A2 Regulatory Signage For Consideration by Council on June 16, 2020



OBJECTIVE:

To amend the current Parking Control, Rate of Speed and Stop Control by-laws to include the regulatory signage required for the new roads constructed in Phases 1, 2, 3A1 and 3A2 of the Avalon Subdivision in Caledonia and establish Thompson Road and MacLachlan Avenue as one way streets.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. THAT Report ENG-02-2020 Avalon Phase 1, 2, 3A1 and 3A2 Regulatory Signage be received;
- 2. AND THAT Haldimand County Rate of Speed By-Law 1942/18, Schedule "A", be amended as outlined in Report ENG-02-2020;
- 3. AND THAT Haldimand County Parking Control By-law 307/02, Schedule "C" No Parking Caledonia, be amended as outlined in Report ENG-02-2020;
- 4. AND THAT Haldimand County Stop Control By-Law 1955/18 Schedule "A" Caledonia, be amended as outlined in Report ENG-02-2020:
- 5. AND THAT a by-law be presented to establish one-way traffic on MacLachlan Avenue and Thompson Road in Caledonia.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

As Phases 1, 2, 3A1 and 3A2 of the Avalon Subdivision are nearing final acceptance of infrastructure, the Highway Traffic Act requires that the regulatory signage must be enacted by by-law. The Consolidated Rate of Speed By-law, Parking Control By-law and Stop Control By-Law must be modified to include the new subdivision roads. The one way streets of Thompson Road and MacLachlan Avenue are also required to have by-laws to be enforced under the Highway Traffic Act.

Once enacted the no parking zones will become enforceable as signage is already in place and the remaining traffic controls will become enforceable as the signage is installed.

Haldimand County will send notices to the property owners of Phases 1, 2, 3A1 and 3A2 of the subdivision informing them of the enforcement of the parking restrictions. Empire Communities have been asked to include notices in the new owner welcome packages that informs future residents of the enforcement of on street parking restrictions.

Thompson Road and MacLauchlan Avenue will occasionally operate as two way streets during the continuing construction of the current and future phases of the Avalon Subdivision. During these times,

the one way signage will be covered and notification signage will be installed to advise motorists of the change in operation of the streets.

BACKGROUND:

Phases 1, 2, 3A1 and 3A2 of the Avalon subdivision includes 6.2 kilometres of new roads requiring regulatory signage. The Highway Traffic Act requires that the Rate of Speed By-Law, Parking By-Law and Stop Control By-law must be amended to include the regulatory signage for the new roads. The one way streets of Thompson Road and MacLachlan Avenue are also required to have by-laws to be enforced under the Highway Traffic Act.

ANALYSIS:

Rate Of Speed

The Highway Traffic Act (HTA) allows for Municipal Councils to prescribe different rates of speed than those prescribed in the Act for highways under municipal jurisdiction. The HTA states that the rate of speed is 50 km/h within a built-up area and 80 km/h otherwise. Municipalities are able to designate through by-law, different rates of speed as long as the posted speed is not greater than 100 km/h.

The County has included all sections of roadway within its jurisdiction in the current Rate of Speed Bylaw and to be consistent, the new roadways within Phases 1, 2, 3A1 and 32A will be added by making the following additions to the Haldimand County Rate of Speed by-law 1942/18:

Parking Controls

The Highway Traffic Act (HTA) requires that the approved no parking signage be enacted under by-law to become enforceable. and allow for smooth traffic operation and visibility for the public. The no parking zones also allow for proper maintenance of the roads.

Parking and signage plans for phases 1, 2, 3A1 and 3A2 of the Avalon subdivision in Caledonia were approved by the County through the subdivision approval process. A map of the no parking zones is included as Attachment 1.

To create the no parking zones for the subdivision, the following changes to Haldimand County Parking Control By-law 307/02 are required:

Once enacted the no parking zones will become enforceable as signage is already in place. Haldimand County will send notices to the property owners of Phases 1, 2, 3A1 and 3A2 of the subdivision informing them of the enforcement of the parking restrictions. Empire Communities have been asked to include notices in the new owner welcome packages that informs residents of the enforcement of on street parking restrictions.

Stop Control

The Highway Traffic Act (HTA) allows for a Municipal Council to implement stop conditions at intersections of highways under its jurisdiction. A by-law must be enacted to legitimize the 47 locations of stop control within Phases 1, 2, 3A1 and 3A2 of the Avalon subdivision. A map of the stop controlled intersections is included as Attachment 2.

To create the stop controls for the subdivision, the following changes to the Haldimand County Stop Control By-Law 1955/18 Schedule "A" are required:
