

THE CORPORATION OF HALDIMAND COUNTY

By-law Number /20

Being a by-law to authorize the sale of Vacant Land on the East Side of Thorburn Street South, Cayuga

WHEREAS the Corporation of Haldimand County declared the lands legally described as PIN # 38230-0114(LT), Part Lot 22, S/S Chippewa Street, Village of Cayuga; Part Lot 23, S/S Chippewa Street, Village of Cayuga; Part Lot 18, N/S Princess Street, Village of Cayuga; Part Lot 19, N/S Princess Street, Village of Cayuga; Haldimand County (the "Lands"), to be surplus to the needs of the Corporation, in accordance with Haldimand County By-law No. 269/02;

WHEREAS the Corporation of Haldimand County deems it in the best interest of the Corporation to sell the Lands;

AND WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law has been published in the local newspaper in Haldimand County which has a general circulation in the area of the subject lands,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the appropriate documents to enable the sale of various closed roads in Cayuga, legally described as PIN # 38230-0114(LT), Part Lot 22, S/S Chippewa Street, Village of Cayuga; Part Lot 23, S/S Chippewa Street, Village of Cayuga; Part Lot 18, N/S Princess Street, Village of Cayuga; Part Lot 19, N/S Princess Street, Village of Cayuga; Haldimand County to 2271313 Ontario Inc. for a purchase price of Twenty Three Thousand Four Hundred Eighty One Dollars and Fifty Cents (23,481.50) plus HST;
2. **THAT** the Clerk is hereby authorized to affix the Corporate Seal to this by-law and to all other documents as required herein.
3. **AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take full effect from the date of passage thereof.
