This email originates from outside of Haldimand County.

On September 23, a document was released outlining the minutes and position that was adopted after a recent meeting of the **Haldimand Police Services Board**. This meeting contained a position of that board that the OPP ought to increase violent enforcement of an interim injunction placed on 1492 Land Back Lane, as well as the Land Defenders and their supporters, who have been involved with the reclamation of the site.

Discussions from this meeting of the Haldimand Police Services Board are deeply troubling and alarming. The language used is biased, and completely inappropriate for a board that is supposed to represent civilian oversight for the OPP, and not act as a pressure group to demand violent and aggressive language and tactics.

The Board must be accountable for their words and their actions which direct OPP and others to use violence towards Skyler Williams, the 1492 Land Back Lane Camp, the entire Six Nations community, and their supporters. Their statement is an attempt to direct police to take the most extreme enforcement tactics against the Six Nations Community, and the rightful stewards and title holders of this land.
