Media Relations Conducted our usual media relations throughout the month (Crime of the Week, etc.).

- Continued writing script for East Link Cable / 92.9 The Grand re partnerships featuring unsolved crimes for Haldimand and Norfolk.

#### **Fundraising**

- Fundraising has been significantly adversely affected due to cancellation of major fundraising events due to COVID-19
- Shredding Event October 17, 2020– Hagersville –raised \$1668.00.
- Planning is underway for 2021 fundraising factoring in likely ongoing restrictions due to COVID. Plans underway for rain barrel sale that can be conducted online with delivery in April, 2021.

- Crime Stoppers has partnered with Transport Canada and Rail line companies to combat vandalism and property damage to rail lines throughout Canada commencing Sept. 21. A media campaign was launched during Rail Safery Week on Sept. 21, 2020.
