By-law Number /20

**Being a by-law to amend By-law 307/02 to regulate parking
in Haldimand County (Main Street East – Dunnville,
MacNeil Court – Hagersville)**

WHEREAS Section 10 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* S. O. 2001 c. 25, as amended (Act) provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting any service or things that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

WHEREAS in accordance with the Act, the Council of the Corporation of Haldimand County enacted the By-law 307/02 to regulate and govern traffic and the parking of vehicles on private or municipal property in Haldimand County;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of Haldimand County now deems it expedient to amend By-law 307/02 with respect to parking regulations on Main Street East in Dunnville and MacNeil Court in Hagersville,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** Schedule “C” No Parking – Dunnville of By-law 307/02 be amended by deleting the section as follows:

STREET	SIDE	FROM	TO	PERIOD
Main Street East	North	150 metres west of Niagara Street	168 metres west of Niagara Street	Anytime

2. **THAT** Schedule “C” No Parking – Dunnville of By-law 307/02 be amended by adding the section as follows:

STREET	SIDE	FROM	TO	PERIOD
Main Street East	North	150 metres west of Niagara Street	190 metres west of Niagara Street	Anytime

3. **THAT** Schedule “C” No Parking – Hagersville of By-law 307/02 be amended by adding the section as follows:

STREET	SIDE	FROM	TO	PERIOD
MacNeil Court	East	60 metres north of Emily Street	70 metres north of Emily Street	Anytime

4. **THAT** this by-law shall take precedence over any other by-law with which is inconsistent.
5. **AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect when signage applicable to this provision has been installed and is on display.

READ a first and second time this 14th day of December, 2020.

READ a third time and finally passed this 14th day of December, 2020.
