I am pleased to advise you that the Haldimand County has been selected for funding through the Ministry of Transportation's 2021-22 Connecting Links Program. Your project may now proceed without delay upon receipt of this letter subject to the conditions noted below.

The ministry's maximum provincial contribution for your project is \$820,665 towards the resurfacing of Broad Street (Oak Street to Pine Street in Dunnville).
