
i see a large lot with a home and agricultural buildings that would be occupied year round.

so i see two problems with this submission.

- 1. the road is not a public road and it is signed as such with no winter access. this area is not zoned for year round occupancy as this winter road is not a reliable access for the services required- fire, ambulance and police.
- if they were allowed to build then our association would be paying for their driveway. this is unreasonable as the traffic from a full time dwelling would greatly exceed the weekend traffic that normally occurs in the summer months only.
