CTAS Level II Patients. Requires emergent care and rapid medical intervention. (i.e. head injury, heart attack)	Paramedic response in seventeen (17) minutes or less *Set by Haldimand County 90%	92.58% (674 of 728 calls)	91.04% (610 of 670 calls)	89.00% (688 of 773 calls)	91.41% (745 of 815 calls)	89.74% (796 of 887)

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CTAS Level III Patients. Requires urgent care. (i.e. mild asthma)	Paramedic response in seventeen (17) minutes or less *Set by Haldimand County 90%	89.83% (1245 of 1386 calls)	90.22% (1,190 of 1,319 calls)	89.39% (1306 of 1461 calls)	89.87% (1260 of 1402 calls)	87.64%(1312 of 1497 calls)
CTAS Level IV Patients. Requires less urgent care. (i.e. earache)	Paramedic response in twenty (20) minutes or less *Set by Haldimand County 90%	95.14% (841 of 884 calls)	93.11% (932 of 1,001 calls)	94.29% (990 of 1050 calls)	94.26% (904 of 959 calls)	93.44% (911 of 975 calls)
CTAS Level V Patients. Requires non-urgent care. (i.e. sore throat)	Paramedic response in twenty (20) minutes or less *Set by Haldimand County 90%	97.39% (224 of 230 calls)	93.84% (259 of 276 calls)	91.78% (268 of 292 calls)	94.83% (275 of 290 calls)	95.02% (267 of 281)
