- 6. AND THAT staff be authorized to undertake an Expression of Interest process to secure concession and vending operators for the Haldimand County Caledonia Centre, Dunnville Memorial Arena and Hagersville Arena;
- 7. AND THAT following an evaluation process, authority to approve the recommended contractors be delegated to the General Manager, Community & Development Services with the Mayor and Clerk authorized to execute the new agreements;
- 8. AND THAT, waiving of concession and vending operator rental fees in the amount of \$14,767 and as outlined in report CDP-12-2021 - during periods of Arena shutdown due to the pandemic - be approved and reflected in the County's financial reporting associated with the province's Safe Restart Program grant;

9. AND THAT the 2021 Tax-Supported Operating Budget revenues associated with concession and vending operations be adjusted to reflect the changes.
