

## THE CORPORATION OF HALDIMAND COUNTY

By-law Number /23

### Being a by-law to amend By-law 2385/22 being a by-law to regulate stop conditions - Dunnville

**WHEREAS** Section 27 (1) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, c. 25., as amended, authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws in respect of a highway under its jurisdiction;

**WHEREAS** Section 137 subsection (a) of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990., c. H.8, as amended authorizes a municipal council to pass by-laws providing for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways under its jurisdiction;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of Haldimand County deems it expedient to amend By-law 2385/22 with respect to stop conditions in the County,

**NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:**

1. **THAT** Schedule "A" – Stop Location of By-law 2385/22 be amended by deleting the following:

Street	Intersection (at)	Traffic Direction
Alder Street East	Cedar Street	Westbound
Alder Street East	Cedar Street	Eastbound

2. **THAT** Schedule "B" – All Way Stop of By-law 2385/22 be amended by adding the following:

Street	Intersection (at)	Traffic Direction
Alder Street East	Cedar Street	All Way

3. **THAT** this by-law shall take precedence over any other by-law with which it is inconsistent.
4. **AND THAT** this by-law comes into force and takes effect when signage and applicable to this provision has been installed and is on display.

READ a first and second time this 26<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2023.

READ a third time and finally passed this 26<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2023.
