Would like to Map the Event August 20-25 (one day, weather permitting with the Wainfleet Mayor). Will provide COI for the mapping as well.

The event: starting in Niagara (Wainfleet) at the Wainfleet Fire Hall at 9am will continue along the feeder Canal (road allowance) towards Dunnville. There will be a break at the Canadian Tire Parking for bagged lunch to take place (brought by each individual Rider). Then return to the Wainfleet Fire Hall.

There may be times when the riders will need to be on Canal Bank Road as well as the Feed Canal Road - for safety reasons.

There will be road crossings to occur at each junction - ride officials will facilitate safe crossings while wearing reflective vests.
