

## THE CORPORATION OF HALDIMAND COUNTY

By-law Number /23

### Being a by-law to amend By-law 302/02 – Winter Parking Control By-law (Caledonia, Dunnville and Jarvis)

**WHEREAS** Section 10 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 S. O. 2001 c. 25, as amended (Act) provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-law respecting any services or things that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

**WHEREAS** in accordance with the Act, the Council of the Corporation of Haldimand County enacted the By-law 302/02 to regulate parking of vehicles on municipal roads within Haldimand County in respect to snow clearing;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of Haldimand County now deems it expedient to amend Schedule “A” of By-law 302/02 with respect to Snow Routes and Schedule “C” of By-law 302/02 with respect to Specific Exemptions,

**NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows;**

1. **THAT** Schedule “A” Snow Route – Dunnville of By-law 302/02 be amended by adding the following section:

STREET	SIDE	FROM	TO
Ross Avenue	East	Alder Street West	South Cayuga Street West

2. **THAT** Schedule “C” Specific Exemptions – Caledonia of By-law 302/02 be amended by adding the following section:

STREET	SIDE	FROM	TO
Orkney Street East	South	90 metres east of Nairne Street	Banff Street

3. **THAT** Schedule “C” Specific Exemptions – Jarvis of By-law 302/02 be amended by adding the following sections:

STREET	SIDE	FROM	TO
Peel Street East	North	60 metres west of Craddock Street	Westerly to end
Peet Street East	South	40 metres west of Craddock Street	Westerly to end
Craddock Street	West	42 metres north of Talbot Street	82 metres north of Talbot Street

4. **THAT** this by-law shall take precedence over any by-law with which it is inconsistent.
5. **AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect when signage applicable to this provision has been installed and is on display.

READ a first and second time this 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2023.

READ a third time and finally passed this 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2023.
