Report ENG-15-2024 Parking By-law Amendment, Elmvale Court, Townsend For Consideration by Council in Committee on October 29, 2024



OBJECTIVE:

To receive Council approval to amend Haldimand County Winter Control By-law 302/02 and Haldimand County Parking Control By-law 307/02 to modify parking regulations on Elmvale Court in Townsend.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

In response to a request raised by the local Councillor regarding the alternate side parking in Townsend, staff have reviewed the parking conditions on Elmvale Court. Based on the review, the number of available parking spaces can be increased and visibility improved for vehicles accessing driveways by establishing an all-year parking zone on the west side of the west leg of Elmvale Court.

BACKGROUND:

As shown in the attached aerial photo (Attachment 1), Elmvale Court is a D-shaped street accessible from Forest Park Drive. Currently, parking regulations allow for alternate side parking (odd/even) and prohibit parking from November 15 to April 15 to accommodate winter maintenance activities.

Area residents have contacted the local Councillor, requesting year-round parking on the west side of the west leg of Elmvale Court, between house numbers 27 and 43. This change would increase the number of available parking spaces and improve visibility for vehicles accessing driveways in this section.

ANALYSIS:

Staff have reviewed conditions and the proposed parking changes will benefit local residents who currently park on the street with enough space remaining for effective snow clearing and garbage pick up during winter months.

To implement these changes, the following amendments to the Haldimand County Winter Control Parking By-law 302/02 and Haldimand County Parking By-law 307/02 are required:
