*Please allow this communication to serve as confirmation that I ,
as a representative of the Twin Heights Subdivision , am requesting time
at the Council In Committee meeting on **October 3rd , 2017**, to speak
as a Delegation regarding the property known as Lot 16 / Plan 82 in Haldimand County.*

*As I believe was explained previously , the residents of the neighborhood known as
TWIN HEIGHTS are passionate about retaining the green space that we have all become
so proud of . While there seems to be some confusion through Council and Staff, and
some were unaware that there are in fact two lots there , residents were always of the
impression that there was in fact ONE piece of Green Space , with 120 feet of frontage.
When Yours Truly attended Council , some 20 years ago , for the same reason – disposal -
we thought the matter was settled , and we had “A Park”.
In addition , some original residents helped fund AND build it in “the day”!*

*Now , suddenly , it seems that pressure in other areas of spending , on bigger items,
has staff searching for areas of possible revenue for the County , such as one lot , so
that Caledonia can grow by **3501 homes instead of 3500** .
This little envelope garners many compliments , and much praise from visitors and family
members who live out of town. The funds realized will not be enough to balance the books.*

*Many have purchased here because of the influence this little Green Space has had on them.
We respectfully request that **Status Quo** remains , trees and all .*
