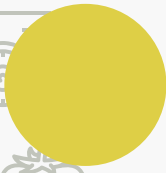


Haldimand County Festival and Special Event Grant

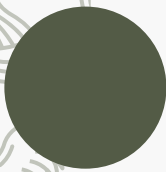

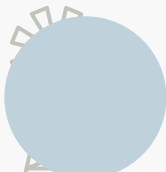
