5.2.1 Community Museums Operating Grant (CMOG)

Requirements for 2025 have been provided – this year the Ministry would like to see a Digitization Strategy reflect the museum's overall digital capacity and future plans to demonstrate that the museum is well positioned to provide digital services moving forward. Application deadline, June 30, 2025.

5.2.2 Young Canada Works 2024-2025 and 2025-26

YCW Internship will conclude March 31 after 27.5-weeks; great success completing oral histories (Bick's Pickles and Hagersville 150th); and additional content for HCTV and the Museums on-line resources). 2025-2026: Confirmation of three successful grant applications. Haldimand Museums has received funding for two 12-week summer placement (Collections Assistant) and a 25 week Intern (Videographer/Content Developer) beginning in September.

- 5.3 Grand River Sachem Digitization Project Update provided by staff – Haldimand Museums are in the final stages of finalizing an agreement with Newspapers.com that will see microfilm of Grand River Sachem digitized and indexed and made available both on-line, via Newspapers.com and at the Museum sites.
