

THE CORPORATION OF HALDIMAND COUNTY

By-law Number /25

Being a by-law to authorize entering into an Ontario Transfer Payment Agreement for the Housing-Enabling Water Systems Fund Intake 2 with His Majesty the King in right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Infrastructure

WHEREAS Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS the Province of Ontario created the Housing-Enabling Water Systems Fund (HEWSF) comprising of two intake periods for municipalities to apply for to assist in repairing, rehabilitating and expanding core water, wastewater, and stormwater infrastructure;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Haldimand County applied for funding through Intake 2 for the Highway 6 Water Main Twinning to Hagersville project;

AND WHEREAS the Province of Ontario on January 7, 2025, provided notice to the municipality that it was successful in receiving funding for the project up to \$\$10,526,600, subject to a Transfer Payment Agreement;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of Haldimand County deems it desirable and necessary to enter into an Ontario Transfer Payment Agreement to access the funding

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** Schedule "A" – Ontario Transfer Payment Agreement Housing-Enabling Water Systems Fund: Intake 2 between His Majesty the King in right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Infrastructure and the Corporation of the Corporation of Haldimand County attached hereto, forms part of this by-law.

2. **THAT** the CAO and Treasurer are hereby authorized to execute the Transfer Payment Agreement on behalf of the Corporation.
3. **AND THAT** this by-law shall take force and effect upon the passage hereof
